

Selectmen's meeting October 20, 2009

Those present: Lynn Sweet, chairperson, Stephanie Gray and R. Stephen Leighton

The meeting was called to order at 6 P.M.

There were no appointments scheduled.

First order of business was the opening of bids for the generator for the Town Hall. Six sealed bids were received as below.

Generator Connection of Barrington- \$26,800 for a 50 kilowatt generator

E J Swasey Electric of Rochester - \$20,050 for a 50 kilowatt generator

Gemini Electric – Auburn NH - \$39,960 for a 50 kilowatt generator

Beloin Construction out of Rochester -\$25,775 for a 60 kilowatt generator

Yankee Electric & Co. LLC of Rochester –50 kilowatt generator - \$27,020

Interstate Electric Services-Bedford - \$31,829 for a 50 kilowatt generator

The propane connection which would be \$300-\$500 additional was not included in any of the bids. The bids did include the generator, the pad, the tank and the transfer switch.

No decision was made at this time.

Other business:

Recycling Center- Florescent Safety Vests and hard hats need to be purchased for the employees at the Recycle Center. The Board agreed to make the purchase for the safety of the employees.

Standard Fees will apply to all items brought into the Recycling Center. The Board will discuss what is going to be acceptable for placement in the "good as new" shed, at a later date.

Correspondence:

The State of NH Department of Safety sent a notice of a hearing to determine whether the public interest requires the use of moorings permits within Bow Lake.

The Town Attorney sent a letter advising the Board that their rates will not be changing.

Workmen's Comp and Health Insurance rates were discussed.

There being no further business it was moved, seconded and voted to adjourn at 6:53 P.M.
