The meeting was called to order at 6 P.M.

Review of checks and bills to be paid

Other business

The Proposal for Professional Services from Dubois and King Inc. was reviewed and discussed.

The State of NH Department of Safety sent a notice of a hearing to determine whether the public interest requires the use of moorings permits within Bow Lake. After a discussion of the public safety issues for boaters and snowmobilers the Board voted to support the request for permits.
